2021 could not have been a better year for Faith and Fostering! We reached a milestone as this year was the first full year of serving homeless young adults. It has been amazing to watch as God has brought his people together to support this ministry to serve his children. As we grow, more people are needed to carry

out our mission "to foster homeless young adults through community and connections to live a life of hope and purpose." This past year, God blessed us with the resources to hire two part-time positions, a Case Manager and Resident Advisor for Holly's Haven (a F&F home). We anticipate God expanding our territory to serve more young adults and grow our staff while increasing our ability to serve in the upcoming year. # **FAITH AND FOSTERING PROGRAMS**

#### LAUNCH PROGRAM

The LAUNCH Program serves homeless youth by providing safe housing, social support through mentors and volunteers, an independent living plan, traumafocused Christian counseling, life skills with the exception of housing. The classes, and support to assist in the strengthening of independent living skills.

### SEND PROGRAM

The **SEND Program** serves at-risk youth that have unstable housing and is at-risk of becoming homeless. F&F provides mentors and all the support offered to participants in LAUNCH goal of SEND is to strengthen independence to avoid homelessness. All SEND participants are in Extended Foster Care or have a history of foster care.

### RESOURCE AND REFERRAL

The F&F RESOURCE AND REFERRAL **CENTER** offers assistance and direction to anyone in regards to youth homelessness, life after foster care, or needed resources. If F&F can't provide assistance, we refer to other agencies to assist if possible.

- <u>Mentoring</u>: Homeless young adults have one thing in common—lack of resources. The number one resource needed is other people. Each young adult in F&F is paired with a Christ-centered mentor.
- <u>Volunteers</u>: F&F utilized volunteers to assist in transportation, intercessory prayer, indoor and outdoor workdays, supply drives, and serving on committees.
- <u>Group support:</u> Join the prayer team, provide meals for events, host celebrations, or organize house warming parties.
